TOUR 400: BELLA ITALIA

13 DAYS: VENICE, ASSISI, ROME, PADRE PIO, BARI, MARATEA

Day 1: DEPARTURE DAY (B,D)

Our journey begins as we board our Trans-Atlantic flight to Milan, Italy. Dinner and breakfast served onboard.

Day 2: MILAN- PADUA (D)

Upon arrival at the Milan airport you'll be greeted by your tour director with a warm welcome. Afterwards motor through the scenic Piedmont wine region and the fertile Po valley to Padua, home of St. Anthony, for dinner and overnight.

Day 3: PADUA - VENICE (B)

Mass at the exquisite Basilica of St. Anthony, the Chapel containing his tomb and the high altar adorned with bronze panels by Donatello depicting his miracles. Then, we are off to dream-like Venice. A guided walk features St. Mark's Square and Basilica, Rialto Bridge and the elaborate Doge's Palace with its Bridge of Sighs leading to the dungeons. You have the remainder of the day to live your dream in this high-spirited city. Maybe enjoy a ride in one of the world-famous Venice gondolas. Return to Padua for overnight.

Day 4: PADUA - FLORENCE - ASSISI (B,D)

We motor past Bologna to Florence, the splendid capital of Tuscany. A guided walk illuminates Florence's riches of Renaissance spirit: the marble cathedral, Giotto's Bell Tower, the Baptistery with Ghiberti's 'Doors of Paradise', Santa Croce Church and the famed Ponte Vecchio spanning the Arno River. Afterwards, we continue through the Chianti wine region and past the spectacular Umbrian Hilltop towns to Assisi. Dinner and overnight.

Day 5: ASSISI (B,D)

After Mass at the crypt of St. Francis, we explore the huge Basilica above. Next we visit the Church of St. Claire where her remains can be viewed. In lower Assisi, we visit St. Mary of the Angels Basilica. Inside, we enter the Porziuncola and view the thornless rosebush and the cane where St. Francis retired for prayer. Dinner and overnight.

Day 6: ASSISI - LORETO - LANCIANO - PADRE PIO (B,D)

After breakfast, we head east past the spectacular mountain scenery of the Apennines to Loreto. At the 'Holy House of Nazareth', we learn about the history of the Shrine of Our Lady of Loreto. Then we are onto Lanciano for devotions at the 8th century Eucharistic Miracle. Afterwards, we continue along the Adriatic coastline to San Giovanni Rotondo, hometown of Saint Padre Pio for dinner and overnight.

Day 7: SAN GIOVANNI ROTONDO- MONTE SANT' ANGELO (B,D)

After Mass we take a guided tour of Padre Pio's church to learn about the life of the saint and the events that have taken place here. We tour the Cathedral, second largest church in the world. In the afternoon we ascend Monte Sant'Angelo for a visit to the Grotto of the Archangel Michael, a celebrated shrine of Christianity. Dinner and overnight.

Day 8: SAN GIOVANNI ROTONDO - BARI - MARATEA (B,D)

After breakfast we are on to Bari, where we visit the Basilica of San Nicola, (St. Nicholas), also known as Santa Claus all over the world. Originally from Myra, Turkey, St. Nick chose Bari as his burial site according to legend. Here we visit his tomb and celebrate Mass if possible. Later we cross the Italian peninsula to our next destination, the coastal town of Maratea, also known as the town of 44 churches. Here we visit the Basilica of St. Blaise, which houses his remains. Every year on the second Sunday in May a procession takes place in his honor. In front of the Basilica, on top of Monte San Biagio you can view the Statue of Christ the Redeemer made of pure marble by the sculptor Bruno Innocenti. Dinner and overnight.

Day 9 : MARATEA - CAPRI - SORRENTO (B)

This morning we motor along the world-famous Amalfi coast, known for its exceptional beauty. We take a ferry to Capri, one of the world's most enchanting islands, for an afternoon excursion. Overnight Sorrento.

Day 10: SORRENTO-POMPEII-MONTECASSINO-ROME (B,D)

After breakfast we drive to Pompeii covered by the ashes of Mt. Vesuvius in 79 A.D. Today we can see how an ancient Roman city looked and lived. The extensive forum, lavish temples, patrician villas and the business district reflect their flourishing past. Afterwards we continue to the Abbey of Montecassino, founded by St. Benedict in 529. After the 1944 bombings it has been completely restored. We celebrate Mass at the crypt of St. Benedict and later motor to Rome for dinner and overnight.

Day 11: ROME (B,D)

This morning, we tour Rome's major basilicas: St. John Lateran and the Holy Stairs, St. Maria Maggiore and St. Paul's Outside the Walls. Later we drive along the ancient Appian Way to the Catacombs where the early Christians buried their dead. The remainder of the day you may wish to explore Imperial Rome - the Forum and the Colosseum, and toss a coin in the Trevi Fountain.

Day 12: ROME (B,D)

This morning, we visit humongous St. Peter's Basilica and attend the Papal Audience with the Holy Father (if held). Afterwards, we explore the Vatican Museum and Michelangelo's celebrated 'Last Judgment' in the Sistine Chapel.

Day 13: RETURN FLIGHT OR 4-NIGHT SICILY EXTENSION (\$795 extra)

Time has come to say arrivederci as we transfer to the airport for our flight back home.

DEPOSIT & FINAL PAYMENT. A deposit in the amount of \$500 per person is due upon receipt of your confirmation. It will hold your reservation until 90 days before departure when the balance becomes due. Late payments are subject to a \$50p.p fee, if payment received within 30 days or less a surcharge of up to \$500p.p may apply.

TOUR PRICES quoted include double occupation airfare from New York/Newark and are based on current tariffs such as airfares and foreign currency exchange rates as known June 2023 They are subject to change should revisions become necessary prior to receipt of the final payment.

PRE-TRIP INFORMATION.

CANCELLATION & REFUND. If the Traveler Cancels: Refund in full, except for a \$100 handling fee, will be made if the written cancellation is received more than 60 days prior to a tour's scheduled departure. Thereafter cancellation fees are:

GENERAL INFORMATION

TOUR DOCUMENTATION. About 60 days before departure you will receive your tour documents. The travel document portfolio includes your air tickets, tour membership list, your personal final itinerary name badge, baggage tags and helpful information for your trip.

AIR TRANSPORTATION. Air transportation is by major scheduled carriers, usually via American and European airlines. The choice of carrier to some extent is determined by the area of origin of the group's majority. For those handling their own connecting flights to a U.S. gateway, the international air schedule is available upon request 45-30 days prior to departure. We recommend that passengers handling their own trans-Atlantic air (land only reservations) contact Go Ever Happy Tour, Lda about 30 days before departure with their arrival details.

TRAVELING ALONE? Tour prices are based on two persons sharing a room. Go Ever Happy Tours, LLC, uses great care to arrange congenial rooming for nonsmoking single traveler. A limited number of single rooms are available at the single room supplements indicated.

TRIPLE ROOMS: Triple rooms are available to families and friends at the listed per-person triple room reductions.

CHILDREN: Tour participants under 18 years old must be accompanied by an adult. Children 5-11 years of age receive a 10% discount on land. Please inquire regarding children under 5 years of age.

VACCINATIONS: None are required.

SMOKING: Smoking is not allowed on motor coaches. Single travelers who smoke are required to book a single room at the single room supplement indicated with each itinerary.

BAGGAGE: For your and your fellow travelers' comfort and because of limited motor coach capacity we kindly ask that you travel with only one suitcase, not to exceed 50 lbs, 62in.

PASSPORTS: A valid passport is required of all tour members. U.S. passports: Please apply through your post office or if you live in a larger metropolitan area directly from the passport office. U.S. passports must be valid for 6 more months after the return date of your trip.

VISAS: It will be the tour member's responsibility to contact the consulates of the countries that require issuance of a visa, (for instance Europe, Turkey, India) and to be in possession of the needed visas before commencement of the tour.

SPECIAL DIETS: Dietary meals maybe reserved in advance on airliners. During the tour dietary food generally can be prepared on request. Additional details will be provided with your confirmation.

HANDICAPPED tour member requiring special assistance en route must travel with a companion to look after his or her well being. Additional details will be provided your confirmation.

FOREIGN CURRENCY: As you will be traveling on an inclusive tour, there is little need to buy currency before your arrival in a country. Current exchange rates are part of your final itinerary.
