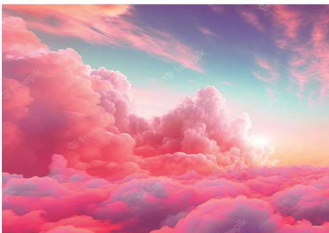

Day 10: Iguazu – Santiago de Chile (B,D)

After a leisurely morning we are ready to be whisked to the airport for our flight to the Chilean capital, Santiago de Chile. Upon arrival you'll be greeted by your local guide and transferred to your hotel for dinner and overnight.

Day 11: Santiago de Chile (B, D)

Our sightseeing includes San Cristobal Hill, site of the Sanctuary of the Immaculate Conception graced by the 14-meter tall statue of the Virgin Mary. On the pedestal there is a small chapel where St. John Paul II prayed and blessed the city on April 1, 1987. We celebrate Mass there, if possible

Day 12: Santiago de Chile – Maipu (B,D)

After breakfast our excursion takes us to nearby Maipu, where we visit the Basilica of Our Lady of Mount Carmel, 300 feet tall. Its construction was ordered by Bernardo O'Higgins in 1818 as a thanksgiving to Our Lady of Mt. Carmel for the victory of the Chilean army over the Spanish at the battle of Maipu, resulting in the independence of Chile. The wooden sculpture of Our Lady of Carmel was brought to Chile in 1785 by Martin de Ceca. On April 3, 1987 the image was crowned as Queen and Patroness of Chile by St. John Paul II during his visit there. We celebrate Mass. Afternoon free for souvenir shopping. Dinner and overnight.

Day 13: Return Flight (B)

After an exciting and enlightening pilgrimage we have to say 'adios' as we transfer to the airport for our flight back home.

TOUR 400A: ITALY, SICILY, & MALTA

Day 1 Departure (B,D)

Our trans-Atlantic flight takes us to Rome, the eternal city. Breakfast and dinner served onboard.

Day 2 - Rome (B,D)

Upon arrival at Fiumicino airport , you'll be greeted by your local guide and transferred to your hotel for dinner and overnight. HOTEL CAPANNELLE.



Day 3 - Rome – Papal Audience (B,D)

Pope Francis will be launching the 2025 Jubilee Year by opening the Holy Door on Christmas Eve this year. It will last until January 6, 2026, the feast of Epiphany. The underlying theme is "Pilgrims of Hope". Pilgrims passing through the Holy Door of St. Peter's Basilica during the Holy Year 2025, going to confession, receiving communion, and praying for the intentions of the pope, can receive an indulgence. This morning we attend the Papal audience by the Holy Father (if held) and receive his blessings. Afterwards we explore the Vatican Museum and Michelangelo's celebrated Last Judgment in the Sistine Chapel. Return to the hotel for dinner and overnight.

Day 4 - Rome (B,D)

Today we tour Rome's major basilicas: St. Peter's Basilica, St. John Lateran and the Holy Stairs, St. Maria Maggiore and St. Paul's Outside the Walls. Dinner at a typical Roman trattoria. Holy doors will be open at all basilicas.

Day 5 - Rome - Assisi (B)

After breakfast we motor to Assisi, hometown of Italy's patron saint, St. Francis. After Mass (if possible at the crypt of St. Francis) we explore the huge Basilica above. Next we visit the Church of St. Clare where her remains can be viewed. In lower Assisi we visit St. Mary of the Angels Basilica. Inside we enter the Porziuncola and view the thornless rosebush and the cave where St. Francis retired for prayer. Return to Rome for dinner and overnight.

Day 6 - Rome - Catania (B,D)

Today we have to say 'arrivederci Roma' as we transfer to the airport for our flight to Catania in Sicily. Upon arrival you'll get a pick-up and continue to your hotel for check-in and overnight.

Day 7 - Taormina - Mt. Etna (B,D)

This morning we enjoy a guided walking tour of the well-preserved ruins of the Greek amphitheater and marvel at what is considered by many the most beautiful views of all of Italy. After lunch we ascend Mount Etna, the highest (c. 3350m) volcano in Europe and one of the largest and most active in the world, nowadays UNESCO World Heritage Site. Its regional park protects 59,000 hectares of unique geology, flora and fauna, villages and farms, and traditional methods of forestry, bee-keeping, wine manufacture, stonework and carpentry. Views of stunning landscapes will amaze you heading to Rifugio Sapienza. You will reach the "Crateri Silvestri", small volcanic cones now inactive, surrounded by ancient lava flows. The view beyond the mountain's hundreds of subsidiary cones and craters, can extend across the whole of Sicily, the Aeolian islands and Calabria. The spectacle is unique!

Day 8 - Syracuse (B,D)

After breakfast we motor to Syracuse where we celebrate Mass at the Shrine of Our Lady of Tears - Madonna delle Lacrime. The small statue of the Virgin Mary wept for five days. We tour the Basilica, shaped like a teardrop. Afterwards we visit the Archaeological Park of Neapolis, with its Greek Theatre, the Roman Amphitheatre, the Latomie of Paradise and the Ear of Dionysius, World Heritage Site. Return to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

Day 9 – Catania - Malta (B,D)

We transfer to the airport for our flight to Malta. Upon arrival pick-up and proceed to hotel for check-in and overnight.

Day 10 - Malta (B)

Two periods stand out in Malta's history from a Catholic viewpoint: the Shipwreck of the Apostle Paul, as narrated in the Bible, and the period of the Knights of St. John. To start with the first, St. Paul's is of course the patron saint of Malta. As for sites, there is no factual historical record, but he is believed to have shipwrecked in what is now St. Paul's Bay. During his 3-months stay in 60 AD, he is said to have lived in what is now the St. Paul's Grotto. Popes Benedict and St. John Paul II have visited it. Nearby, one finds the St. Paul's Catacombs and the St. Agatha's Catacombs, both linked to early Christianity in Malta. The Sovereign Military Hospitaller Order of St. John of Jerusalem, of Rhodes, and of Malta, commonly known as the Knights of Malta ruled the Islands for almost 3 centuries until 1798. Their legacy has been very well preserved and can be seen everywhere, most especially in Valletta and the Grand Harbour area. It is for this reason that Malta serves as a backdrop for countless historical movies. We spend one day in Valletta, which allows us visits to the Grand Master's Palace and the St. John's Co-Cathedral, the two most important sites in Malta. The Upper Barracca Gardens allow us splendid views over the Grand Harbour, still protected by the original bastion walls and fortresses like St. Angelo and St. Elmo that were built by the Knights, and which have been splendidly restored.

Day 11 - Malta (B)

This morning, after breakfast, we explore Valletta with the Upper Baracca Gardens, St. John's Co-Cathedral and the Grand Master's Palace. We drive by the St. Paul's Bay & Islands for a photostop. Similarly, we might be able to visit the Sanctuary of Our Lady of Mellieha.

CANCELLATION & REFUND. If the Traveler Cancels: Refund in full, except for a \$100 handling fee, will be made if the written cancellation is received more than 60 days prior to a tour's scheduled departure. Thereafter cancellation fees are:

GENERAL INFORMATION

TOUR DOCUMENTATION. About 60 days before departure you will receive your tour documents. The travel document portfolio includes your air tickets, tour membership list, your personal final itinerary name badge, baggage tags and helpful information for your trip.

AIR TRANSPORTATION. Air transportation is by major scheduled carriers, usually via American and European airlines. The choice of carrier to some extent is determined by the area of origin of the group's majority. For those handling their own connecting flights to a U.S. gateway, the international air schedule is available upon request 45-30 days prior to departure. We recommend that passengers handling their own trans-Atlantic air (land only reservations) contact Go Ever Happy Tour, Lda about 30 days before departure with their arrival details.

TRAVELING ALONE? Tour prices are based on two persons sharing a room. Go Ever Happy Tours, LLC, uses great care to arrange congenial rooming for nonsmoking single traveler. A limited number of single rooms are available at the single room supplements indicated.

TRIPLE ROOMS: Triple rooms are available to families and friends at the listed per-person triple room reductions.

CHILDREN: Tour participants under 18 years old must be accompanied by an adult. Children 5-11 years of age receive a 10% discount on land. Please inquire regarding children under 5 years of age.

SPECIAL DIETS: Dietary meals maybe reserved in advance on airliners. During the tour dietary food generally can be prepared on request. Additional details will be provided with your confirmation.

HANDICAPPED tour member requiring special assistance en route must travel with a companion to look after his or her well being. Additional details will be provided your confirmation.

FOREIGN CURRENCY: As you will be traveling on an inclusive tour, there is little need to buy currency before your arrival in a country. Current exchange rates are part of your final itinerary.
