TOUR 500: MUNICH, INFANT OF PRAGUE & POLAND

12 DAYS: MUNICH, PRAGUE, WARSAW, KARKOW

Day 1 – DEPARTURE DAY (B,D)

Our journey begins as we depart on our trans-Atlantic flight to Munich. Dinner and breakfast served on board.

Day 2 – MUNICH (B,D)

Upon arrival in the Bavarian capital we will be met by our European tour manager. Our city drive includes Old Town, Marian Square, Old and New Town Hall with its Glockenspiel. Tonight we get to know each other better over a Stein of beer while listening to folk music in world-famous Hofbrauhaus.

Day 3 – MUNICH – NEUSCHWANSTEIN (B)

After breakfast, we enjoy the ride through the scenic countryside of the Alps to the Church in the Wies, known for its splendid rococo interior. We continue to the magnificent Barvarian Castle, the fantasy-like creation by 'crazy' King Ludwig II. Here we join a guided tour of Neuschwanstein Castle., after which the Disneyland Castle was modeled. In the afternoon we return to Munich for overnight.

Day 4 – MUNICH – PRAGUE (B,D)

After a leisurely morning in Munich we journey through scenic Barvarian countryside to Prague, capital of the Czech Republic. Remainder of the day at leisure. Tonight, we enjoy dinner at a traditional local restaurant.

Day 5 – PRAGUE (B,D)

Our morning tour of Prague starts at the "Little Quarter" with a visit to the Church of Our Lady Victorious and home of the Infant of Prague. From 1000-year-old Hradcany Castle we take in the breathtaking panorama of the Czech capital, considered by many to be Europe's most beautiful. Next we explore St. Vitus's Cathedral, illuminated by colored light from its huge stained glass windows. Its exquisitely ornate Chapel of St. Wenceslaus houses the tomb of the Good King who was tragically murdered by his brother. We then descend to the Old Town Square to view the magnificent Astronomical Clock. The remainder of the day is free for independent exploration, including the many shops selling bargain-priced hand-blown glass, puppets, and wooden toys.

Day 6 – PRAGUE – WROCLAW – WARSAW (B,D)

We journey through the picturesque Czech countryside and cross into Poland. At lunchtime we reach Wroclaw, a university city rich in remarkable works of art and architecture. Later we continue to Warsaw for dinner and overnight.

Day 7 – WARSAW (Excursion to Fr. Kolbe's Convent) (B,D)

Severely damaged during World War II, Warsaw has been restored with great care to its former stateliness. Our sightseeing includes the picturesque cobblestone Old Town Square lined with open-air cafes and idyllic houses abundantly decorated with flowers. An afternoon excursion takes us to Niepokalanow, a small town dominated by the monastery which once was the home of Maximilian Kolbe. During a guided visit of the ornate church, the monastery and the living quarters of Fr. Kolbe, we hear about the life of the heroic saint. Return to Warsaw for dinner and overnight.

Day 8 – CZESTOCHOWA (B,D)

Leaving the Polish capital, we head south through lush countryside to Czestochowa. After Mass we have a guided visit of the Shrine of Jasna Gora monastery, home of the venerated Black Madonna of Czestochowa, the "Queen of Poland". Remainder of the day at leisure. Dinner and overnight.

DAY 9 – AUSCHWITZ – WADOWICE – KRAKOW (B,D)

We follow a route dotted with the ruins of medieval castles to Auschwitz, a grim reminder of one of history's darkest hours. Our 3-hour guided tour includes camp Auschwitz I & II, the cell block where Fr. Maximilian Kolbe was held, and Birkenau displaying the unloading ramp. We continue to Wadowice, birthplace of Saint Pope John Paul II. We visit the 16th-century parish church where a plaque commemorates Karol Wojtyla's baptism and the museum depicting his life. Then we continue to Krakow for dinner and overnight.

Day 10 – KRAKOW – KALWARIA (B,D)

Much of this city's beauty comes from its medieval churches, ancient squares, and strong ramparts. A tour of Krakow includes Wawel Castle commanding a splendid view over the city, the Cathedral which was the seat of Cardinal Karol Wojtyla before becoming Pope, magnificent Krakow Town Square and its centuries-old marketplace, Sigismund Chapel containing the tomb of Polish aristocracy, national heroes, and bishops; not to forget Flouanska Gate and the 12-th century Virgin Mary Church with its ornate altars and also featuring the hourly "Hejnal Mariacki" trumpet tap. In the afternoon we explore Kalwaria Zebrzydowska, the second largest Marian Shrine in Poland, consisting of no less than 42 churches and chapels.

Day 11 – KRAKOW (SISTER FAUSTINA & SALT MINES) (B,D).

We drive to the convent of Sister Faustina. One of the sisters will tell us about the history of the saint. After our visit we motor to the Wieliczka Salt Mine which appears on UNESCO's list of the "World's Cultural Heritage" sites. We explore the chambers of the blessed Kinga and St. Anthony of the Holy Cross and the spectacular cathedral carved entirely from salt, including the gigantic chandeliers. Return to Krakow. Tonight we enjoy a special farewell dinner with wine, music and folkloric dances at a popular local venue.

Day 12 – RETURN FLIGHT (B)

The time has come to say "good bye" as we transfer to the airport for our flight back home.

CANCELLATION & REFUND. If the Traveler Cancels: Refund in full, except for a \$100 handling fee, will be made if the written cancellation is received more than 60 days prior to a tour's scheduled departure. Thereafter cancellation fees are:

90-45 days before.....	\$500
45-30 days before.....	50% of tour price
29-15 days before.....	75% of tour price
14 days or less.....	100% of tour price

Airline and other cancellation charges, if any, will be added to above fees up to a maximum of 100%. Allow 4 weeks, depending on time of cancellation before departure. GENERAL INFORMATION

TOUR DOCUMENTATION. About 60 days before departure you will receive your tour documents. The travel document portfolio includes your air tickets, tour membership list, your personal final itinerary name badge, baggage tags and helpful information for your trip.

AIR TRANSPORTATION. Air transportation is by major scheduled carriers, usually via American and European airlines. The choice of carrier to some extent is determined by the area of origin of the group's majority. For those handling their own connecting flights to a U.S. gateway, the international air schedule is available upon request 45-30 days prior to departure. We recommend that passengers handling their own trans-Atlantic air (land only reservations) contact Go Ever Happy Tour, Lda about 30 days before departure with their arrival details.

TRAVELING ALONE? Tour prices are based on two persons sharing a room. Go Ever Happy Tours, LLC, uses great care to arrange congenial rooming for nonsmoking single traveler. A limited number of single rooms are available at the single room supplements indicated.

TRIPLE ROOMS: Triple rooms are available to families and friends at the listed per-person triple room reductions.

CHILDREN: Tour participants under 18 years old must be accompanied by an adult. Children 5-11 years of age receive a 10% discount on land. Please inquire regarding children under 5 years of age.

VACCINATIONS: None are required.

SPECIAL DIETS: Dietary meals maybe reserved in advance on airliners. During the tour dietary food generally can be prepared on request. Additional details will be provided with your confirmation.

HANDICAPPED tour member requiring special assistance en route must travel with a companion to look after his or her well being. Additional details will be provided your confirmation.

FOREIGN CURRENCY: As you will be traveling on an inclusive tour, there is little need to buy currency before your arrival in a country. Current exchange rates are part of your final itinerary.
