TOUR 700: ENCHANTING EUROPE

Day 1 - DEPARTURE DAY

Trans-Atlantic flight to Frankfurt. Dinner and Breakfast served inflight.

Day 2 - RUEDESHEIM

Upon arrival in Frankfurt, Germany, we are met by our European tour director and transferred to Ruedesheim. The remainder of the day is at your disposal to take in the atmosphere of centuries past and walk cobble-stoned Drosselgasse. Tonight, we get acquainted with our fellow travelers over dinner.

Day 3 - RUEDESHIEM

(ST. HILDEGARD, RHINE RIVER CRUISE, LORELEI) (B,D)

We cross the Rhine to Bingen and ascend to the Abbey of St. Hildegard. After mass and a visit, we board a Rhine River Boat for a down-river cruise past fairy-tale towns, castles, and terraced vineyards. Later, our coach climbs up to the top of the legendary Rock of the Lorelei. Dinner and overnight.

Day 4 - HEIDELBERG - SANKT BLASIEN (B,D)

After breakfast, we head south and soon reach Heidelberg on the banks of the Neckar River. We stop at the red-walled castle overlooking Germany's oldest university town. Later, we journey along the pine-covered hills of the Black Forest to Einsiedeln, Switzerland. Later we journey along the Rhine Valley to Sankt Blasien, located in the heart of the Black Forest. The town owes its name to St. Blaise, the saint known for healing illnesses of the throat. He was beheaded in the 4th century, his feast day is February 3rd. The town's Cathedral is dedicated to the martyr saint and contains some of his relics. We marvel at the humongous abbey, formerly a Benedictine monastery, now a Jesuit college. An enormous statue in the property's garden reminds us of his martyrdom by being ripped apart by iron combs and finally being beheaded. Dinner and overnight.

Day 5 - SANKT BLASIEN - EINSIEDELN (B,D)

After breakfast we depart Sankt Blasien and motor along the pine-dotted hills of the Black Forest crossing into Switzerland to our final destination Einsiedeln. Its huge Benedictine monastery was founded by St. Meinrad in 946 and is the home of the Black Madonna. The venerated statue has been saved from destruction through many fires and pillages. We finish our day by celebrating Mass in the chapel of the church. Dinner and overnight.

Day 6 - EINSIEDELN - LUCERNE (B)

This morning our day excursion takes us to breathtaking Lucerne. We follow the shores of Lake Lucerne to explore the unique wooden bridges dating back to the 14th century and not to forget shopping for those Swiss quality army knives, watches, and other famous Swiss-made products. Tonight you might want to sample one of those unique Swiss fondues for dinner. Return to Einsiedeln for overnight.

Day 7 - LIECHTENSTEIN- INNSBRUCK - SALZBURG (B,D)

This morning, we depart for Liechtenstein and its capital, Vaduz. We then journey along the Arlberg route through Alpine Austria to Innsbruck, Tyrol. An orientation drive through the city includes the Little Golden Roof and Maria Theresien Street for an impressive view of the Tyrolean Alps in the backdrop. Afterwards, we continue to Salzburg, our final destination for today. Dinner and overnight.

Day 8 - SALZBURG (B)

Our morning sightseeing of Salzburg's Altstadt (Old Town), a UNESCO World Heritage Site, includes the birthplace of musical prodigy Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart, the famous Getreidegasse, the Jewish district and Cathedral. Wander through the narrow streets with some buildings dating back to the Middle Ages. The afternoon is free for independent exploration of this wonderful city. You might want to take the opportunity to visit some of the sites used in the original 'Sound of Music'. Dinner and overnight.

Day 9 - SALZBURG - ETTAL - OBERAMMERGAU (B,D)

After breakfast we depart Salzburg and motor through the enchanting scenic Alpine region crossing into Germany on our way to the monastery of Ettal. After Mass and a visit we drive to nearby Oberammergau, the village famous for its houses adorned with murals and flowers and the outstanding woodcarving talents of its inhabitants. Oberammergau is even better known for its Passion Plays, Christ's sufferings performed every ten years by the villagers as a thanksgiving for having been spared of the plague which ravaged the country in 1633. Dinner and overnight.

Day 10: OBERAMMERGAU - NEUSCHWANSTEIN CASTLE - MUNICH (B,D)

After breakfast, we enjoy the ride through the scenic country side of the Alps to the Church in the Wies, known for its splendid rococo interior. We continue to the magnificent Barvarian Castle, the fantasy-like creation by 'Crazy' King Ludwig II. Here, we join a guided tour of Neuschwanstein Castle, after which the Disneyland Castle was modeled. In the afternoon we are on to Munich, capital of Bavaria. Tonight we are having fun in the world-famous Hofbrauhaus listening to the local brass band while enjoying a typical Bavarian dish and a Stein of beer.

Day 11 - MUNICH - PRAGUE (B,D)

After breakfast we journey through the picturesque Bavarian countryside to Prague, the capital of the Czech Republic. Remainder of the day at leisure. Dinner and overnight.

Day 12 - PRAGUE (B,D)

Our morning tour starts at the 'Little Quarter' with a visit to the Church of Our Lady Victorious and home of the Infant of Prague. From 1000-year old Hradcany Castle, we enjoy the breath-taking panorama of the Czech capital, considered by many to be Europe's most beautiful. Next, we explore St. Vitus Cathedral, illuminated by colored light from its huge stained glass windows. Its exquisitely ornate Chapel of St. Wenceslaus houses the tomb of the Good King who was tragically murdered by his brother. We then descend to the Old Town Square to view the magnificent Astronomical Clock. The remainder of the day is free for independent exploration. Dinner and overnight.

Day 13 - RETURN FLIGHT (B)

We say 'Auf Wiedersehen' as we transfer to the airport for our flight back home.

CANCELLATION & REFUND. If the Traveler Cancels: Refund in full, except for a \$100 handling fee, will be made if the written cancellation is received more than 60 days prior to a tour's scheduled departure. Thereafter cancellation fees are:

GENERAL INFORMATION

TOUR DOCUMENTATION. About 60 days before departure you will receive your tour documents. The travel document portfolio includes your air tickets, tour membership list, your personal final itinerary name badge, baggage tags and helpful information for your trip.

AIR TRANSPORTATION. Air transportation is by major scheduled carriers, usually via American and European airlines. The choice of carrier to some extent is determined by the area of origin of the group's majority. For those handling their own connecting flights to a U.S. gateway, the international air schedule is available upon request 45-30 days prior to departure. We recommend that passengers handling their own trans-Atlantic air (land only reservations) contact Go Ever Happy Tour, Lda about 30 days before departure with their arrival details.

TRAVELING ALONE? Tour prices are based on two persons sharing a room. Go Ever Happy Tours, LLC, uses great care to arrange congenial rooming for nonsmoking single traveler. A limited number of single rooms are available at the single room supplements indicated.

TRIPLE ROOMS: Triple rooms are available to families and friends at the listed per-person triple room reductions.

SPECIAL DIETS: Dietary meals maybe reserved in advance on airliners. During the tour dietary food generally can be prepared on request. Additional details will be provided with your confirmation.

HANDICAPPED tour member requiring special assistance en route must travel with a companion to look after his or her well being. Additional details will be provided your confirmation.

FOREIGN CURRENCY: As you will be traveling on an inclusive tour, there is little need to buy currency before your arrival in a country. Current exchange rates are part of your final itinerary.
